- Counselor Training is required for all Leadership and Counselors.
- High School Staff Training is required for all Junior Counselors and suggested for Counselors-in-Training.
- Priority will be given to Leadership and Counselor applicants who can work the entire summer. It is not necessary for Junior Counselors (JC's) and Counselors-in-Training (CIT's) to be available for the entire summer.
- JC's and CIT's are not paid to work Family Weekends, but may work on a volunteer basis at the Camp Director's discretion.
- In order to be eligible to work the Grand Fir session, first time staff members must attend High School Staff Training and work at least one other session prior to Grand Fir.
